ABOUT THE DAKOTA BANDS PROGRAM

The Dakota Bands Program is an award-winning organization comprised of two Concert Bands, Symphonic Band, Wind Ensemble, Jazz Band, a Saxophone Ensemble, a Brass Ensemble, Marching Band, Color Guard, Winter Drumline and Winter Guard. We have over 150 high school students that participate in the Dakota Bands Programs.

Our four Concert Bands consistently earn Division I and Superior ratings at festivals. In addition to full band MSBOA festivals, we host three concerts during the school year. We also have students participating in Solo & Ensemble, Chamber Ensemble, Large Percussion Ensemble, State MSBOA, Honors Bands, All-State Band and the Honors Performance Series in New York.

Our Marching Band and Color Guard compete in the MCBA (Michigan Competing Bands Association) in addition to home football game performances. This competitive circuit includes four to five invitational competitions during the Fall season. In 2019, 2021 and 2022 they have participated in the MCBA State Finals at Ford Field with Marching Bands from all over the state of Michigan. The Dakota Marching Band is also invited to participate in the Richmond Parade and the America's Thanksgiving Day parade each year.

Our Winter Drumline and Winter Guard compete in multiple competitions across the state during the winter season. In 2019, the Winter Drumline placed 2nd at MCGC state championships earning the silver medal in their class. In 2020, the drumline was named Winter Guard International Sports of the Arts (WGI) Regional Champions. In April 2022 the Winter Drumline came in second place and took home the silver medal at the MAPA State Championships and in 2023 they were 1st Place - State Champions! Our Winter Guard program is growing and competes in the State Finals for the Michigan Color Guard Circuit each year.
